BEGINNING at an iron pin 15 feet southeast from the northeast corner of tract bought by L. L. Jarrard from Mountain Lake Colony, Incorporated, April 12, 1939, and running parallel with line of Ferguson property but 15 feet from it; S 86-45 W 300 feet to an iron pin; thence S 5-40 E 140 feet to a large oak tree with an identifying iron pin on the north side of it; thence N 86-45 E to line of property deeded by W.
