TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: **Frances T. Welborn**

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the sum of ----- **Thirty-Seven Hundred and No/100** ----- DOLLARS (\$ **3700.00**), with interest thereon at the rate of **6 3/4** per cent per annum as evidenced by the Mortgagor's note of even date herewith payable as therein stated, or as hereafter modified by mutual agreement, in writing, the final maturity of which is **seven** years after the date hereof, unless extended by mutual consent, the terms of said note and any agreement modifying it are incorporated herein by reference; and

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, **containing one acre, more or less, and being shown and designated as Lot 10.4, Block 1, Page B 4.4 of the County Block Book, and having according to a plat of the Property of Frances T. Welborn, unrecorded, the following metes and bounds:**

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of Motor Boat Road, and running thence S. 22-30 E. 363 feet to pin; thence with line of property now or formerly of Tatham, S. 70 W. 120 feet to pin; thence N. 22-30 E. 363 feet to pin on edge of Motor Boat Road; thence with the southern side of said Road N. 70 E. 120 feet to the point of beginning."
