Description:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northern side of Washington Loop, the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 39 and 40, Block D., and running thence along the joint line of said lots North 21-11 West 105.1 feet to an iron pin; the joint rear corner of said lots; thence along the rear lines of Lots No. 39 and 38, Block D, South 62-49 West 52.5 feet to an iron pin on the rear line of Lot No. 38, Block D; thence on a new line through Lot No. 38, Block D., South 27-11 East 112 Feet, more or less, to an iron pin on the northern side of Washington Loop, North 56-27 East 52.95 feet to the beginning corner, and being the same property conveyed to Willimon Jones by deed of Robert H. Stewart, dated December 31, 1956, and recorded in the RMC office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Book 568, page 85.
