

County, to Compressor Station 150, located in Iredel County, all in the State of North Carolina. Included in this loop section are a main line valve assembly with double cross-overs to a header at the beginning of the loop and a main line valve and scraper trap assembly and a tie-over to the existing suction line at Compressor Station 150.

(b) One 42-inch main line loop section (Line "D"), approximately 0.36 miles in length, beginning at the South Carolina-North Carolina State Line, and continuing in an easterly direction to the end of the loop section at Compressor Station 145, all in Cleveland County, North Carolina. Included in this loop section are a main line valve and scraper trap assembly and a cross-over to the existing suction line at Compressor Station 145.

(c) One 42-inch main line loop section (Line "C"), approximately 6.19 miles in length, beginning at approximate mile post 1380.10, and continuing in an easterly direction to the west end of the existing loop at approximate mile post 1386.33, all in Rockingham County, North Carolina.

VIRGINIA

One 42-inch main line loop section (Line "C"), approximately 35.94 miles in length, beginning at approximate mile post 1521.82, located in Louisa County, and continuing in an easterly direction, crossing Orange and Culpeper Counties, to the west end of the existing loop, located in Fauquier County, at approximate mile post 1557.76, all in the state of Virginia. Included in this loop section are a main line valve and scraper trap assembly with cross-over to the header assembly at the beginning of the loop section, a main line valve assembly with a tie-over to the suction line at Compressor Station 180, and a main line valve assembly with a tie-over to the discharge line at Compressor Station 180.

PENNSYLVANIA

One 24-inch main line loop section (Line "B"-Leidy), approximately 14 miles in length, beginning at approximate mile post 129.52, located in Penn Township, and continuing in a westerly direction to the end of the loop section, located in Loyalsock Township, all in Lycoming County, Pennsylvania.
