at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the said

James L. Snow, his heirs and assigns:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed situate, lying and being the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Fairview Township, bounded on the north by lands of J. T. Hipps, on the east by W. M. Fowler, on the south by Drubin Creek and on the west by W. C. Cook and more particularly described as follows: BEGINNING at an iron pin, 627.1 feet from the joint corner of J. T. Hipps corner and W. M. Fowler line, and running thence along Hipps line N77-26W, 97.7 feet, thence N88-11W, 107.7 feet to iron pin, thence S20-15W 180 feet to iron pin, thence S 64-45E, 200 feet to iron pin thence, N20-15E 244.3 feet to point of beginning containing one acre.
