The following described property being real estate situate in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, O'Neal Township, about one half mile west from O'Neal lying on the south-east side of the road that leads from the Mayes Bridge Road to the O'Neal School and on the northern side of a community road, being bounded on the northwest by the above named road and lands of W. E. Duncan, on the east by lands of myself and on the southwest by lands of H. M. Fitts, and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by deed from W. E. Duncan September 12, 1944, recorded in the office of the RMC for Greenville County in Deed Book 267 at page 280, and having the following courses and distances to wit:-

Beginning on an iron pin in the center of the above named road, joint corner of lands of W. E. Duncan and of H. M. Fitts and I. E.
