"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon,

situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being shown as Lot 39, Section 1, on plat of Oak Crest, recorded in Plat Book GG at pages 110-111, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at an iron pin on the southwestern side of Templewood Drive, at the joint front corner of Lots 39 and 40, and running thence with line of Lot 40, 5.75-17 W 145 feet to an iron pin; thence N 14-58 W 75.2 feet to an iron pin at corner of Lot 38; thence with line of said lot, N 75-17 E 145.1 feet to an iron pin on the southwestern side of Templewood Drive; thence with said Drive, S 14-43 E 75 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same property conveyed to the mortgagor by Deed Book 774, page 577, RMC Office for Greenville County.
