All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, located on the Northern side of North Main St., formerly known as Mostella Road, in or near the City limits of Greer, S.C., and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING in the center of said road and running thence N. 42-45 W. 420 feet more or less to iron pin; thence S. 80-35 W., 392 feet along lends now or formerly of Vernon Duncan, to corner of other property of Truman Henderson; thence S. 19-35 E., 155.7 feet to iron pin; thence still with Truman Henderson S. 35-25 W., 28.3 feet to iron pin; thence S. 11-55 E., 5 ffet to iron pin; thence along lends now in the name of John Carbaugh (to be conveyed to Truman Henderson) S. 47-36 W., 56 feet to iron pin; thence S. 14-15 W., 50.7 feet to said road; thence with said road S. 47-35 E., 167 feet to the beginning corner.
