To HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said property unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that he is lawfully select of the premises bereinabove described in fee simple absolute (or such other estate, if any, as is stated hereinbefore), that he has good right and lawful authority to sell, convey, or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances whatsoever except as herein otherwise receited. Privilege is reserved to prepay at any time, without premium or fee, the entire indebtedness or any part thereof not less than the amount of one initializant, or one hundred dollars (\$100.00), whichever is less.
- Together with, and in addition to, the monthly payments of principal and interest payable under the terms of the note secured hereby, he will pay to the Mortgagee as trustee (under the terms of this trust as hereinafter stated) on the first day of each month until the said note is fully paid:
 - (a) A sum equal to the ground rents, if any, next due, plus the premiums that will next become due and payable on policies of fire and other hazard insurance covering the mortgaged property, plus taxes and assessments next due on the mortgaged property (all as estimated by the Mortgages, and of which the Mortgages is notified) less all sums already paid therefor divided by the number of months to elapse before one month prior to the date when such ground rents, premiums, taxes and sessements will become delinquent, such sums to be held by Mortgages in trust to pay said ground rents, premiums, taxes and special assessments.
 - (b) The aggregate of the amounts payable pursuant to subparagraph (a) and those payable on the note secured hereby, shall be paid in a single payment, each month, to be applied to the following items in the order stated:
 - (1) taxes, special assessments, fire and other hasard insurance premiums;
 - (ii) interest on the note sequed hereby; and
 (iii) amortisation of the principal of said note.

Any definicacy in the amount of such aggregate monthly bayment, shall, 'unless made good by the Mortgagor prior to the due date of the next such payment, constitute an event of default under this mortgage.
