TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the property unto the Government and its assigns forever,

EDRROWER for himself, his heirs, executors, administrators, successors and essigns WARRANTS THE TITLE to the property to the Government against all lawful claims and demands whatinever except any liens, excumbrances, essenants, reservations, or conveyances specified hereinshove, and COVENANTS AND AGREES AS FOLLOWS.

- (1) To pay promptly when due any indebtedness to the Government hereby secured and to indemnify and save harmless the Government salaists any loss under its insurance of payment of the note by reason of any default by Borrower. At all times when he note is held by an insured indee, parcover shall confine to make payments on the note to the Government, as collection agent for the holder.
- (2) To pay the Government any initial fees for inspection and appraisal, and any delinquency charges, now or hereafter required by regulations of the Parmers Home Administration.
