- (3) That it will keep all improvements now existing or hereafter crected in good repair, and, in the case of a construction lean, that it will continue construction until completion without interruption, and should it fall to do so, the Mortgages may, at its option, enter upon said premises, make whatever repairs are necessary, including the completion of any construction work underway, and charge the expenses for such repairs or the completion of such construction to the mortgage debt.
- (4) That it will pay, when due, all taxes, public assessments, and other governmental or municipal charges, fines or other impositions against the mortgaged premises. That it will compty with all governmental and municipal laws and regulations affecting the mortgaged premises.
- (5) That it hereby assigns all rents, issues and profits of the mortgaged premises from and after any default heraunder, and agrees that, should legal proceedings be instituted pursuant to this instrument, any judge having jurisdiction may, at Chambers or otherwise, appoint a receiver of the mortgaged premises with full authority to take possession of the mortgaged premises and collect the rents, issues and profits, including a reasonable rental to be fixed by the Court in the event said premises are occupied by the mortgager and after deducting all charges and expenses attending such praceeding and the execution of its trust as receiver, shall apply the residue of the rents, issues and profits toward the payment of the dobt secured hereby.
- (6) That if there is a default in any of the terms, conditions, or covenants of this mortgage, or of the note secured hereby, then, at the oplion of the Mortgages, all sums then owing by the Mortgages to the Mortgages shell become immediately due and payable, and this mortgage may be foreclosed. - (7) That the Mortgagor shall hold and enjoy the premises above conveyed until there is a default under this mortgage or in the note secured hereby. It is the true meaning of this instrument that if the Mortgagor shall fully perform all the terms, conditions, and covenants of the mortgage, and of the note secured hereby, that then this mortgage shall be utterly null and void; otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.

(3) That the covenents herein contained shall blind, and the bonefits and advantages shall inure to, the respective heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, of the parties hereto. Whenever used, the singular shall included the plural, the plural the singular, and the use of any garder shall be applicible to all garders.
