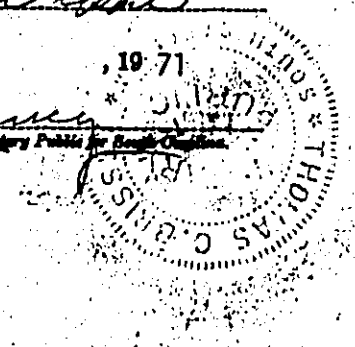

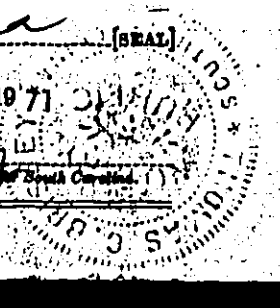
RENUNCIATION OF DOWER
