WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto SALUDA VALLEY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF Williamston, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by

reference, in the sum of THIRTEEN THOUSAND AND NO/100 -----

DOLLARS (\$ 13,000.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of eight (8%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be paid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose, and

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does hereby grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Oaklawn Township, near the Ware Place, being known and designated as Lot No. 18 on a plat of property of J. B. and Ellis King, made by C. O. Riddle, Registered Surveyor, dated October 1965, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northeastern side of Old Hundred Road where the same is intersected by an unnamed street, and running thence with the north side of Old Hundred Road, N. 64-45 E. 125 feet to an iron pin at the joint front corner of Lots 18 and 19; thence with the common line of said lots, N. 25-15 W. 200 feet to an iron pin on the line of Lot 17; thence S. 64-45 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the eastern side of an unnamed street; thence with the eastern side of said unnamed street, S. 25-15 E. 175 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 70-15 E. 35.4 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
