All that certain piece parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, on the southeast side of Washington Loop, and being known and designated as a portion of Lots Nos. 14, 15 and 16, of Block F, of a subdivision known as Washington Heights as shown on plat thereof made by N. O. McDowell and Julian P. Moore, Surveyors, in December, 1944 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book M, at page 107, and having, according to a more recent survey made by C. C. Jones, C.E., in December of 1953, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southeast side of Washington Loop at the corner of a triangular lot heretofore conveyed by J. H. Mauldin to Morris F. Smith, and running thence S 33-20 E 113.6 feet to an iron pin in Lot No. 16, of Block F; thence on a line across Lot No. 16, of Block F, S 2-20 W 148.9 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 15 and 16 of Block F, in line of the property of the Southern Railroad Company right-of-way; thence along the line of Southern Railroad Company right-of-way, S 69-10 W 40 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lots Nos. 14 and 15, of Block F; thence on a new line across Lot No. 15, of Block F, due North, 130 feet, more or less, to an iron pin in Lot No. 15, of Block F; thence on a new line across Lots Nos. 15 and 14, of Block F, N 30-16 W 95 feet to an iron pin in the front line of Lot No. 14, of Block F, on the southeast side of Washington Loop; thence along the southeast side of Washington Loop, N 35-19 E 56 feet to the beginning corner.
