Now, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land, together with buildings and improvements, situate, lying and being at the Southeastern corner of the intersection of Rockvale Drive with Dumont Avenue, in Gantt Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown and designated as Lot No. 200 on a Plat of ROCKVALE, Section 2, made by J. Mac Richardson, Surveyor, dated July 1959 and recorded in the RMC office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book QQ, Page 109, reference to which is hereby craved for the metes and bounds thereof.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and equipment now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with the real estate herein described.
