TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, We the said John R. New and Mary M. New, hereinafter called Mortgagor, in and by Gateway Trailer Sales, Inc. certain Note or obligation bearing even date herewith, stand indebted, firmly held and bound unto THE CITIZENS AND SOUTHERN NATIONAL BANK OF SOUTH CAROLINA, hereinafter called Mortgagee, in the full and just principal sum of Eighteen Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty and No/100 Dollars (\$ 18,950.00), with interest thereon payable in advance from date hereof at the rate of 8 % per annum; the principal of said note together with interest being due and payable in (60) Number

monthly (Monthly, Quarterly, Semi-annual or Annual) installments as follows:
Beginning on August 15, 1971, and on the same day of each monthly period thereafter, the sum of Two Hundred Forty and No/100 Dollars (\$ 240.00) and the balance of said principal sum due and payable on the 15th day of July, 1976.

The aforesaid payments are to be applied first to interest at the rate stipulated above and the balance on account of unpaid principal. Provided, that upon the sale, assignment, transfer or assumption of this mortgage to or by a third party without the written consent of the Bank, the entire unpaid balance of the note secured by this mortgage, with accrued interest, shall become due and payable in full or may, at the Bank's option, be continued on such terms, conditions, and rates of interest as may be acceptable to the Bank.

Said note provides that past due principal and/or interest shall bear interest at the rate of 8 % per annum, or if left blank, at the maximum legal rate in South Carolina, as reference being had to said note will more fully appear; default in any payment of either principal or interest to render the whole debt due at the option of the mortgagee or holder hereof. Forbearance to exercise this right with respect to any failure or breach of the maker shall not constitute a waiver of the right as to any subsequent failure or breach. Both principal and interest are payable in lawful money of the United States of America, at

the office of the Mortgagee in Greenville, South Carolina, or at such other place as the holder hereof may from time to time designate in writing.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, that the said Mortgagor in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Mortgagee according to the terms of the said Note; and also in consideration of the further sum of THREE DOLLARS, to the said Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the said Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mortgagee the following described real estate, to-wit:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lots #17 and 18, Lot K on Plat of Northgate Subdivision recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book M, at Page 13; AND Lots #25, 26, 27, 28 and 29, 30, 31, 32 and 33, Block 2, Section B on Plat of Parkvale as recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book K, at Page 53.

ALSO, all that piece, parcel, or lot of land, situate, lying and being in Garvin Township, Anderson County, S. C., being shown and designated on Plat of same prepared by F. E. Ragsdale, Registered Land Surveyor, dated August 27, 1965 and of record in the Clerk of Court's Office for Anderson County, S. C. in Plat Book 61, at Page 276, said parcel of land, according to said plat, contains 10.63 acres, plus or minus.

ALSO, that certain tract of land containing 65.54 acres, plus or minus, situate, lying and being in Garvin Township, Anderson County, S. C., bounded on the north by lands now or formerly of Cothran on the east, by other lands now or formerly of Florence Dean and Roosevelt Dean, on the south by lands now or formerly of Wilson and Mattison Smith, and on the west by lands now or formerly of Martin and W. A. Brown.
