"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville in the City of Greenville on the South side of West Washington Street, near the Southern Railway Station and having the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin opposite the intersection of Washington Street with Cook Street and Pine Street and running thence in a Northerly direction with Washington Street 70 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot No. 8 as shown on a plat of the W. T. Sumate lands made in 1891 when the same was sold by Julius C. Smith, Assignee, the said lot being now owned or formerly owned by Salina W. Robinson and running thence with her line in a Southwesterly direction erly direction with the extension of Washington Street; thence in a Southcorner of Lot No. 9, formerly owned by A. C.
