TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: J. E. Williams

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the sum of Fourteen thousand eight hundred and no/100----- DOLLARS

(\$14,800.00), as evidenced by the Mortgagor's note of even date, bearing interest as stated in said note, and payable as therein stated or as modified by mutual agreement, in writing, the final maturity of which is -3- years after the date hereof, unless extended by mutual consent, the terms of said note and any agreement modifying it are incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced or readvanced to or for the Mortgagor's account, including advances made by the Mortgagee on other or no security:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the western side of White Horse Road in Paris Mountain Township, being shown as Parcels A, B, and C on plat of the property of J. E. Williams made by Pickell & Pickell, February 27, 1954, and recorded in Plat Book HH at page 15, containing in the aggregate 18.13 acres and when described together has the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of the White Horse Road and running N 84-19 W 954.21 feet to old iron pin; thence N 21-41 E 686 feet to an iron pin by old stone; thence S 77-19 E 799 feet to an iron pin; thence N 4-04 E 199.2 feet to old iron pin; thence S 85-56 E 559.2 feet to an iron pin on White Horse Road; thence with the right of way of said White Horse Road the following courses and distances: S 34-15 W 82.3 feet; S 36-30 W 104 feet; S 37-58 W 605.5 feet; thence S 37-59 W 121 feet to the beginning corner.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
