First Mortgage on Real Estate

MORTGAGE

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA
COUNTY OF GREENVILLE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

JAMES E. KOMER and
SHIRLEY J. KOMER

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the sum of TWENTY EIGHT THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY and No/100-----DOLLARS

(\$ 28,750.00), as evidenced by the Mortgagor's note of even date, bearing interest as stated in said note, and payable as therein stated or as modified by mutual agreement, in writing, the final maturity of which is 30 years after the date hereof, unless extended by mutual consent, the terms of said note and any agreement modifying it are incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced or readvanced to or for the Mortgagor's account, including advances made by the Mortgagee on other or no security:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the western side of Trinity Way shown as Lot 17 on a plat of Northwood Hills, revision of Section I and Section I-A and Section II recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book RR, Page 15, and being further described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of Trinity Way at the joint corners of Lots 16 and 17 and running thence along the line of Lot 16 N.68-04 W. 188.7 feet; thence S.31-55 W. 211.8 feet to an iron pin in the corner of Lot 18; thence along the line of Lot 18 S.74-04 E. 168.2 feet to an iron pin the joint corner of Lots 17 and 18 which pin is on the curve of a turn around; thence along the said curve the chord of which is N.30-00 E. 24.5 feet; thence N.87-12 E. 40 feet to an iron pin; thence N.53-21 E. 41.7 feet to an iron pin on the western side of Trinity Way; thence along Trinity Way N.20-30 E. 115.0 feet to the point of beginning.

This is the identical property conveyed to Joseph P. McMillan, Jr., et al, by deed recorded in Deed Book 788 at page 284.

The mortgagors agree that after the expiration of ten years from the date hereof, the mortgagee may at its option apply for mortgage insurance for an additional period of five years with the mortgage insurance company insuring this loan, and the mortgagor agrees to pay to the mortgagee as premium for such insurance one half of 1% of the principal balance then existing.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
