## PARCEL VII

Lying and being in the Town of Columbus, Polk County, North Carolina, and being more particularly described as follows:

Known and designated as Lots Number 4 and 5 of the block in front of the Polk County Court House.

Adjoining the lot on which the law office of E. B. Cloud is situate, known as Lots 4 and 5 of the block in front of the Polk County Court House, shown on a plat of the John T. Smith Sub-division recorded in Book 44, page 596, Polk County Registry. Said lots were conveyed by John T. Smith and others to O. C. Feagan, Jr., by deed dated June 10th, 1959, recorded in Book 91, page 5, to which reference is hereby fully had to identify and describe said lots.

## PARCEL VIII

A certain tract or parcel of land in Green Creek Township, Polk County, and State of North Carolina, adjoining the lands of Troy Jackson, and J. H. Smith and others, and bounded as follows, vis:

BEGINNING on an iron pin in the Southwest margin of a hard surface road leading from Highway #9 to Chesnee, South Carolina, and known as the Chesnee Highway, said iron pin being the Southeastern corner of the Troy Jackson property and the Northeastern corner of the property herein conveyed, and running thence with the Jackson line, South 48 degs. West 182 feet to an iron pin; thence South 32½ degs. East 50 feet to an iron pin; thence North 48 degs. East 182 feet to an iron pin in the southwestern margin of the Chesnee Highway; thence with the Southwestern margin of said Highway, North 32½ degs. West 50 feet to the BEGINNING.

The above described property is a portion of lot #10 of the Roxie Thompson Farm Subdivision, a plat of said Subdivision being recorded in Deed Book 46, page 601, Polk County Registry.

The above metes and bounds description was taken from a plat entitled, "Property of Thermal Belt Telephone Company, Tryon, North Carolina", made by S. B. Edwards, Surveyor, dated May 3, 1954, reference being had to said plat in aid of the description.

## PARCEL IX

All that certain lot or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the Town of Campobello, State and County aforesaid, and on West side of Street, or Public Road, sometimes referred to as "Motlow Road" leading from Campobello toward Greenville Courthouse; said lot of land hereby conveyed BOUNDED by said Street or Public Road on East, by lands now or formerly of C. M. Cannon and J. M. Caldwell & Son on North, and by lands now or formerly of H. F. King on West and South. Said lot fronting on said Street or Road fifty (50) feet, more or less, and running back one hundred and nine (109) feet, more or less. The South line running back parallel to the North line or lines now or formerly owned by Caldwell & Son and Cannon, and containing one-eighth (1/8) of an acre, more or less. Reference is made to Deed from H. F. King to John N. Isom, dated 6th October 1900, and recorded in Vol. Deeds 3-V., Page 366, R. M. C. Office for Spartanburg County, South Carolina. John N. Isom afterwards conveyed above described lot to A. M. Belus, in fee, for valuable consideration by an unrecorded deed. Reference is also made to the administration of the Estate of A. M. Belus, deceased, as recorded in the Office of the Probate Judge for Spartanburg, Spartanburg County, South Carolina, 1923, and duly filed in Box 111, Package 15, in said office.
