NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, that I the said William M. Cody

in consideration of the said debt, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the conditions of the said Note; which with all its provisions is hereby made a part hereof; and also in consideration of Three Dollars to the said mortgagor in hand well and truly paid, by the said mortgagee, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Consolidated Credit Corp. of Anderson, South Carolina, the following described property being real estate situate in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Saluda Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known as a part of J. E. Cody's estate, adjoining lands of Bill Goodwin on the East Hall, on the West and others;

BEGINNING On iron pin on road leading to the Talley Bridge Road; thence running N. 18½ E. 55 feet to iron pin on said road; thence N. 78 W. 43¼ feet to a stake on branch; thence S. 19¼ E. 57 feet to a stake; thence S. 78 E. 4.00 feet to the beginning corner and contains 47/100 of an acre, more or less,

All that piece parcel or lot of land in Saluda Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known as a part of J. E. Cody's estate, adjoining lands of Bill Goodwin, Guss Cody, and others,

BEGINNING on an iron pin on road leading to the Talley's Bridge Road; thence running N. 18½ E. 55 feet to iron pin; thence N. 78 W. 45¼ feet stake; thence S. 15¼ E. 57 feet to a stake; thence S. 78 E. 43¼ feet to the beginning corner and contains one-half of an acre, more or less.
