All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land being

Alice M. and H. H. Willis as per plat of W. J. Riddle recorded
in Plat Book J, Pages 150 and 151, RMC Office for Greenville
County and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the N. W. side of Clemson
Avenue, said iron pin being 38' from the N. E. corner of Arch
Street and Clemson Avenue, corner of Lots 21 and 22 and running
the N. 53° 45' W. 264.5' to an iron pin on the rear line of Lot
