(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the sum of - - - - - SIX THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY AND NO/100THS- - - - - DOLLARS

(\$ 6,750.00), as evidenced by the Mortgagor's note of even date, bearing interest as stated in said note, and payable as therein stated or as modified by mutual agreement, in writing, the final maturity of which is ten years after the date hereof, unless extended by mutual consent, the terms of said note and any agreement modifying it are incorporated herein by reference; and

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Grove Township, containing Seven-Tenths (7/10ths) acres, more or less, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on corner of lot formerly owned by S. L. Goldsmith lot on East side of Highway 20 (formerly 29); thence along line of S. L. Goldsmith S. 83 E. 6 chains 20 links to center of P & N Railway; thence along center of P & N Railway N. 4 E. 1.20 chains to an iron pin; thence N. 83 W. 6.24 chains to a point in Highway No. 20 (formerly 29); thence S. 10-1/2 E. to an angle in old road bed 20 links; thence S. 4 W. 1.00 along highway to beginning corner.
