

S. 22-23 W. 74.5 feet; S. 23-56 W. 74.2 feet; S. 25-29 W. 100 feet; S. 27-12 W. 52.5 feet; thence with a curve of the intersection of White Horse Road and Duncan Road, the chord of which is S. 38-19 E. 40.8 feet; thence with Duncan Road N. 71-30 E. 100 feet; N. 56-40 E. 100 feet; N. 47-49 E. 155 feet to the point of beginning.

ALSO: All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina on the western side of U. S. Highway No. 25 and being a portion of the property shown on plat of property of W. C. Adams prepared by W. J. Riddle, March 1949 and recorded in the R. M. C.
