NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, that I the said Eloise Nash in consideration of the said debt, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the conditions of the said Note; which with all its provisions is hereby made a part hereof; and also in consideration of Three Dollars to the said mortgagor in hand well and truly paid, by the said mortgagee, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said CONSOLIDATED CREDIT CORP OF GREENVILLE, SC, INC.

All that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate on the West side of McCall Street in the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, and having, according to a survey made by R. K. Campbell on February 20, 1969 the following notes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the West side of McCall Street, said pin being 490.51 feet North from the Northwest corner of the intersection of McCall Street and Rhett Street and runs thence S. 71-48 W. 101 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 18-49-W. 52 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 71-48 E. 101 feet to an iron pin on the West side of McCall Street; thence along McCall Street, S. 18-49 E. 52 feet to beginning corner.

This is the same property conveyed to Mamie E. Stone by deed of L. E. Girardeau dated October 6, 1944, recorded in the REC office for Greenville, County, SC in Deed Book 268, Page 60. Subsequently, Mamie E. Stone died estate and by her will which is on file in the Probate Court for Greenville County, SC, in Apt 887, File 13, she devised a life estate in said property to the grantor M. C. Stone and the remainder to the grantor Earle C. Stone.
