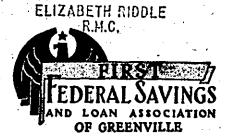

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, located near the Southwest intersection of Old Easley Bridge Road and Old Dunham Bridge Road, and being all of Lot No. 3, the major portion of Lot No. 2 and a small portion of Lot No. 1, shown on a plat of Arthur J.
