in and by a certain promissory note in writing of even date with these presents, are well and truly indebted to **The South Carolina National Bank of national banking association** (hereinafter called Mortgagee) in the full and just sum of **One Hundred Twenty-five Thousand** (\$125,000.00)

Greenville, South DOLLARS, to be paid at its Home Office in Greenville, South Carolina, together with interest on the unpaid balance thereof remaining unpaid from time to time, from date hereof until maturity, ~~according to the terms of a certain promissory note of even date herewith, to which note reference is specifically made, providing for the payment thereof in installments, the last of which is due and payable on or not later than December 1, 1992.~~

If any installment of said principal or interest is not paid when due, or if said note is placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind, a reasonable attorney's fee of not less than ten (10%) per cent of the amount involved shall be added to the amount due under said note and shall be collectible thereunder. If any installment of interest is not payable at its maturity, the same shall thereafter bear interest at the rate of **twelve** per cent per annum until paid. In the event of failure to pay any interest or any installment of principal, or any portion of either, or any other sums required to be paid by said note and this mortgage, as the same become due, or in the event of failure to perform and comply with any and all of the other covenants, terms and provisions of said note and this mortgage, and/or the other instrument or instruments, if any, which secure this note, and such failure or default shall continue for a period of thirty days, then in any of said events said principal sum and all advancements made pursuant to the provisions of this mortgage, together with all unpaid interest thereon shall be at once due and payable at the option of **The South Carolina National Bank of Charleston, Greenville Branch** successors or assigns, and be collectible without further notice, by proceedings or otherwise. Provisions as to prepayment, contained in said note, are incorporated herein by reference.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, that the said Mortgagor, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to the said Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the said Mortgagee, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, that certain tract or parcel of land located in **Greenville** County, State of South Carolina, more particularly described as follows:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the southwestern side of White Horse Road (S. G. Highway 250) and on the southeastern side of Michael Drive near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as a portion of Lot 1 as shown on a plat prepared by Dalton & Neves, dated January, 1963, entitled "Property of Dempsey Construction Company" and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book DDD at page 39, and having according to a more recent plat prepared by R. W. Dalton, dated August, 1972, entitled "Property of United Medical and Surgical Supply Corporation" the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the southeastern edge of the right of way for Michael Drive, which iron pin is located 365.8 feet, more or less, in a southwesterly direction from the southeastern corner of the intersection of White Horse Road and Michael Drive and running thence with the line of Lot 12 of Michael Park S. 61-22 E. 102.25 feet to an iron pin at the joint corner of Lots 1 and 2; thence with the line of Lot 2 N. 38-05 E. 315.2 feet to an iron pin on the southwestern edge of the right of way for White Horse Road; thence with the southwestern edge of said right of way N. 41-45 W. 61.3 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 38-05 W. 162.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 51-55 W. 75.9 feet to an iron pin on the southeastern edge of the right of way for Michael Drive; thence with the southeastern edge of the right of way for Michael Drive S. 30-46 W. 111.7 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the southeastern edge of the right of way for Michael Drive S. 21-30 W. 72.4 feet to the point of beginning.
