All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the north side of Springdale Street (formerly known as Spring Street) and on the south side of Brown Street (formerly known as McAdoo Street), in the town of Greer, and being known and designated as Lot No. Fifty-five (55) of the N. M. Cannon Subdivision as shown on plat prepared by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, dated Jan., 1924 and which plat has been recorded in the R. M. C. Office for said County in Plat Book F, page 199. This being the same property which was conveyed to Harold Sloan by W. A. Christopher by deed recorded in the said office in Deed Book 622, page 435.
