PARTIAL RELEASE OF LIEN

(Bank Loan No. S-193-389)

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar and other considerations, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, The Federal Land Bank of Columbia, the owner and holder of the security instrument hereinafter referred to and of the note(s) thereby secured, does, subject to the conditions hereinafter stated, hereby release from the lien of that certain security instrument from John M. Dillard

to The Federal Land Bank of Columbia, dated the 26th day of April, 1972, and recorded in the public records of Greenville County, State of South Carolina in Mortgage Book 1231 at page 247, the following described property, to-wit:

ALL that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing Seventeen and Forty-Two One-Hundredths (17.42) acres, more or less, and being bounded on the North by Pine Log Ford Road; on the East by other property of John M. Dillard; and on the South and West by lands of Bruster. This being more particularly described on plat of survey by Robert Jordan, U.S. #1208, and dated July 19, 1969.

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that the security of The Federal Land Bank of Columbia as described in the aforesaid security instrument shall, in all respects, except as to the premises hereinbefore described, be preserved and protected and that the lien of said security instrument, except as hereby released and discharged, shall remain in full force and effect and the terms, conditions and covenants thereof and of the note(s) thereby secured, shall remain unchanged.
