Dollars (\$2,150.00) due and payable  
in 60 equal payments of \$36.19 per month. Payments to be applied first  
to interest and then to principal.

with interest thereon from date at the rate of seven per centum per annum, to be paid monthly

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sum or may be advanced to or for  
the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repair, or for any other purpose.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the above-stated, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and  
of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account  
by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagee to be well and truly paid by the  
Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold  
and released; and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situated, lying and being  
in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville and lying and being in Gant Township,  
and being known and designated as Lot 19 as shown on a plat entitled  
Belle Meade Subdivision, and having, according to a plat by Piedmont  
Engineering Service, said plat being recorded in the KBC Office for  
Greenville County in Plat Book BB at page 116 and 117, the following  
metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of East Dorchester Boulevard  
at the joint front corner of Lots 19 and 20 and running thence with the  
line of Lot 20, N. 69-40 E. 167.4 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 21-43 W.  
111.1 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots 18 and 19;  
thence with the joint line of lots 18 and 19, S. 71 W. 90 feet to an iron  
pin on the eastern side of East Dorchester Boulevard; thence with the  
eastern side of East Dorchester Boulevard, N. 19 W. 80 feet to an iron  
pin, the point of beginning.

Together with all and singular rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging in any way, incident or appur-  
tenant, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise in or out theretofore, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting  
fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all fixtures  
and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its heirs, successors and assigns, forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that it is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that it has good right  
and is lawfully authorized to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances except  
as provided herein. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee  
forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
