Together with all and singular the rights, members, bereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging of in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had, therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that he is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple smaller, that he has good right and lawful authority to sell, convey, or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances whatsoever. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises unto the Mortgagoe forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.

The Mortgagor covenants and agrees as follows:

- 1. That he will promptly pay the principal of and interest on the indebtedness evidenced by the said note, at the times and in the manner therein provided.
- 2. That this mortgage shall secure the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs or other purposes pursuant to the covenants herein, and also any further leffns, advances, readvances or credits that may be made hereafter to the Mortgager by the Mortgagee; and that all stains so advanced shall bear interest at the tarme rate as the Mortgage debt and shall be payable on demand of the Mortgagee, unless otherwise provided in writing.
- 3. That he will keep the improvements now existing or hereafter erected on the mortgaged property insured as may be required from time to this by the Mortgagee against loss by fire and other hazards, in such amounts as may be required by the Mortgagee, and in companies acceptable to it, and that he does hereby assign to the Mortgagee all such policies, and that all such policies and renewals thereof shall be held by the Mortgagee and have attached thereto loss payable clauses in favor of, and in form acceptable to the Mortgagee.
- 4. That he will pay when due all taxes, public assessments, and other charges upon or assessed against the mortgaged property.
- 5. That he will keep all improvements now existing or hereafter erected upon the mortgaged property in good repair, and should he fail to do so, the Mortgagee may, at its option, enter upon said premises, make whatever repairs are necessary, and charge the expenses for such repairs to the mortgage debt, that, in the event that the proceeds of this loan are for the construction of improvements on the mortgaged premises, he will continue construction until completion without interruption, and should he fail to do so, the Mortgagee may, at its option, enter upon said premises, complete said pointruction work, and charge the expenses for the completion of such construction to the mortgage debt, and/or the Mortgagee may declare the indebtedness secured hereby due and payable if the Mortgagee shall permit such construction to be and remain interrupted for a period of littery (15) days.
- 6. That the Mortgagee may require the maker, co-maker or endorser of any indebtedness secured hereby to carry life insurance upon himself in a sum sufficient to pay all sums secured by this inortgage, designating the Mortgagee as beneficiary thereof, and, upon failure of the Mortgager to pay the premiums therefor, the Mortgager may, at its option, pay said premiums, and all sums so advanced by the Mortgagee shall become a part of mortgage debt.
- 7. That, together with, and in addition to, the monthly payments of principal and interest payable under the terms of the note secured hereby, he will pay to the Mortgagee (at the Mortgagee's option), on the first day of each month, until the indebtedness secured hereby is paid in full, a sum equal to one-twelfth of the annual taxes, public assessments and insurance premiums, as estimated by the Mortgagee, and, on the failure of the Mortgagor to pay all taxes, insurance, premiums and public assessments the Mortgagee may, at its option, pay and items and charge all advances therefor to the mortgage debt.
- B. That he hereby assigns all the reits, issues, and profits of the mortgaged premises from and after any default hereunder, and should legal proceedings be instituted pursuant to this instrument, then the Mortgage's shall have the right to have a receiver appointed of the rents, issues, and profits, who, after deducting all charges and expenses attending such proceedings and the execution of his trust as receiver, shall apply the residue of the rents, issues, and profits, toward the payment of the debt secured hereby.
- 9. That, at the option of the Mortgagee, the indebtedness secured by this mortgage shall become due and payable if, without the written consent of the Mortgagee, the Mortgager shall convey away the mortgaged premises, or if the title shall become vested in any other person in any manner whatsoever other than by death of the Mortgager. It is understood and agreed that it consideration for the consent of the Mortgager to any transfer for title to the mortgaged premises, the Mortgager at its option may charge a loan transfer fee and/or require changes in the rate of interest, term of loan monthly payments of principal and interest and other, terms and conditions of this mortgage and/or the note secured hereby.
- 10 That the rights of the Mortgagee arising under the clauses and covenants contained in this mortgage shall be separate distinct and cumulative and none of them shall be in exclusion of the others; that the invalidity of one of more of the clauses and covenants contained herein shall not in any way affect the validity or inforceability of the remaining provisions herein contained, and that no act of the Mortgagee shall be construed as an election to proceed under any one provision herein to the exclusion of any other provision, any thing herein or otherwise to the contrary notwithstanding.
- It is agreed that the Mortgager shall hold and enjoy the premises above conveyed until there is a default under this mortgage or in the note secured hereby. It is the true meaning of this instrument that if the Mortgager shall fully perform all the terms, conditions, and coverants of this mortgage, and of the note secured hereby, this mortgage shall be utterly null and void; otherwise to remain in full force and virtue. If there is a default in any of the terms, conditions or covenants of this mortgage, or of the note secured hereby, then, at the option of the Mortgages, all sums then owing by the Mortgager to the Mortgages shall become immediately due and payable and this mortgage may be forcelosed. Should any legal proceedings be instituted for the forcelosure of this mortgage, or should the Mortgagee become a party to any suit involving this Mortgage or the title to the premises described herein, or should the debt secured hereby or any part thereof be placed in the hands of an attorney at law for collection by suit or otherwise; all costs and expenses incurred by the Mortgagee, and a reasonable attornoy's fee, shall thereupen become due and payable, immediately, or on demand, at the option of the Mortgagee, as a part of the debt secured hereby, and may be recovered and cellected hereunder.
