(12) Neither the property nor any portion thereof or interest therein shall be lessed, assigned, sold, transferred, or encumbered, voluntarily or othereins, without the written consent of the Government. The Government shall have the sole and exclusive rights as mortgages betweener, including but met limited to the power to grant consents, partial releases, subordinations, and satisfaction, and no insured leader shall have any right, title or interest in or to the lies or any heaefits hereof.

(13) At all reasonable times the Government and its agents may inspect the property to abcertain whether the covenants and agreements contained herein or in any supplementary agreement kird being performed.
