BEGINNING at a point in the edge of Fork Road and running thence along the joint property line of Lot No. 3, S. 13-30 W., 150 feet to a point; thence along the joint property line of Lot No. 19, S. 76-03 W., 80 feet to a point; thence along the joint property line of Lot No. 1, N. 13-30 E., 150 feet to a point in the edge of Fork Road; thence along the edge of Fork Road, N. 76-03 E., 80 feet to the point of beginning.

The mortgagor and mortgagee agree that any ranges, refrigerators, or carpeting purchased or financed in whole or in part, with loan funds will be considered and construed as a part of the property covered by the mortgage.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the property sate the Government and its assigns fourer.

BORROWER for himself, his beirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns WARRENTS THE TITLE to the property to the Government against all lawful claims and demands whatecever except any liens, encumbrances, easements, reservations, or conveyances specified hereinabove, and COVENANTS AND AGREES as follows:

(i) To pay promptly when due any indebtedness to the Covernment hereby necured and to indemnify and save harmless the Covernment against any loss under its insurance of payment of the note by reason of any default by Borrower. At all times when the note is held by an insured lender, Borrower shall continue to make payments on the note to the Covernment, an collection agent for the holder.

(2) To pay the Covernment such fees and other charges as may now or hereafter be required by regulations of the Farmers Home Administration.

(3) At all times when the note is held by an insured leader, any amount due and unpaid under the terms of the note, less the amount of any tanged charge, may be paid by the Government to the helder of the note as provided in the insurance endorsement for the account of Borrower. Any amount due and unpaid under the terms of the note, whether it is held by the Government or by an insured leader, may be credited by the Government on the note, and thereupon shell constitute an advance by the Government for the account of Borrower. Any advance by the Government as described in this paragraph shall bear interest at the note rate from the date on which the amount of the advance was due to the date of payment to the Government.
