

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

WILLIAM H. HOLLOWAY

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) (SEND(S) GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagoe) in the full and just sum of Eighteen Thousand and No/100----

Dollars, as evidenced by Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, which note does not contain a provision for escalation of interest rate (paragraphs 9 and 10 of this mortgage provides for an escalation of interest rate under certain

conditions), said note to be repaid with interest as the rate or rates therein specified in installments of One Hundred Twenty-

seven and 03/100---- (\$ 127.03 month hereafter, in advance, until the principal sum with interest has been paid in full, such payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on unpaid principal balances, and then to the payment of principal with the last payment, if not sooner years after date; and

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and rapable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any organizations and marginal any collections. or the storigagee, or any supurations see out in this mortgage, the whole amount one increasing at the option of the noncer diction, become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for proceedings, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose,

NOW. KNOW ALL MEN. That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars in hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargamed, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant bargam will and release unto the state of the sum of three presents.

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, Ising and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the southeastern side of Ferol Drive, being shown and designated as Lot No. 73 on a Final Plat of Palmetto Terrace made by J. Mac Richardson, Surveyor, dated July 1, 1958, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book QQ, at page 13, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southeastern side of Ferol Drive at the joint front corners of Lots Nos. 73 and 74 and running thence along the common line of said lots S. 64-14 E. 190 feet to an iron pin; thence along the rear line of Lot No. 3 S. 25-46 W. 70 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 72 and 73; thence along the common line of said lots N. 64-14 W. 190 feet to an iron pin on Ferol Drive; thence along the southeastern side of Ferol Drive N. 25-46 F. 70 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.
