TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

WE, GEORGE E. AND PAMELA R. AIKENS
(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the sum of FIFTEEN THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED (\$15,100.00) ----- DOLLARS

(\$ 15,100.00), as evidenced by the Mortgagor's note of even date, bearing interest as stated in said note, and payable as therein stated or as modified by mutual agreement, in writing, the final maturity of which is **twenty-five** years after the date hereof, unless extended by mutual consent, the terms of said note and any agreement modifying it are incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced or readvanced to or for the Mortgagor's account, including advances made by the Mortgagee on other or no security:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, lying on the Western side of Piedmont Park Road near the City of Greenville, being known as Lot 105 on plat of Property of W. P. Charping and Lillie Mae Charping, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S.C., in Plat Book O, at Page 119, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: BEGINNING at a point on the Western side of Piedmont Park Road at the joint front corner of Lots 105 and 106, and running thence along the common line of said lots N. 74-30 W. 202.1 feet to a point; thence n. 14-12 E. 95 feet to a point; thence along a common line of Lots 104 and 105, S. 74-30 E. 203.1 feet to a point on the Western side of Piedmont Park Road, joint front corner of Lots 104 and 105; thence along the Western side of Piedmont Park Road S. 15-30 W. 95.0 feet to the point of beginning.

The property above described is more clearly shown on plat by R. B. Bruce, R.L.S., dated April 10, 1969, designated as "Property of Barry R. Silver and Mary K. Silver" filed for recording in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina.

SUBJECT to protective covenants, easements and rights of way of record.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
