TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: Murphy N. Pitts

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the sum of Twelve thousand five hundred and no/100ths----- DOLLARS

(\$ 12,500.00), as evidenced by the Mortgagor's note of even date, bearing interest as stated in said note, and payable as therein stated or as modified by mutual agreement, in writing, the final maturity of which is ten years after the date hereof, unless extended by mutual consent, the terms of said note and any agreement modifying it are incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced or readvanced to or for the Mortgagor's account, including advances made by the Mortgagee on other or no security:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

*All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, lying in Butler Township, shown as the property of Johnnie and Wealthy Greer, according to plat prepared by C. O. Riddle dated November 12, 1959, recorded in Plat Book 00 at page 376, in the RMC Office of the Greenville County Courthouse, containing one acre, more or less, and being described, according to said plat, more particularly, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the center of county road running off S. C. Highway No. 145 (sometimes known as the Woodruff Road), and running thence with the center of said county road, N 3-30 W 202.9 feet to an iron pin; thence through an iron pin at the edge of the road, S 74-15 E 322.8 feet to an iron pin; thence S 3-30 E 83.1 feet to an iron pin; thence S 84-00 W 305 feet to the beginning point in the center of the said county road.

The above-described property is the same conveyed to the Mortgagor by deed recorded in the RMC Office of the Greenville County Courthouse in Deed Book 653 at Page 381.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
