Douglas Wilson & Co., a corporation organized and existing under the laws of South Carolina, hereinafter called Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of Eight Thousand Six Hundred Fifty and 10/100-----Dollars (\$8,650.00), with interest from date at the rate of seven per centum ( 7 %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of C.
