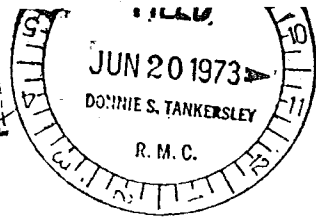

WHEREAS We the said Eliza and Bertha Greene

(hereinafter also styled the mortgagee) in the penal sum of Two Thousand Four Hundred Forty Eight Dollars and no/100—(\$2,448.00) Dollars,

conditioned for the payment in lawful money of the United States of America of the full and just sum of Two Thousand Four Hundred Forty Eight Dollars and no/100—(\$2,448.00)

as in and by the said Note and conditions thereof, reference thereto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, that We the said Eliza and Bertha Greene in consideration of the said debt, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the conditions of the said Note; which with all its provisions is hereby made a part hereof; and also in consideration of Three Dollars to the said mortgagor in hand well and truly paid, by the said mortgagee, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Consolidated Credit Corporation of Greenville, South Carolina, Inc. Its Successors.....

All that lot or tract in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Northern Side of Bramlett Road, and Being a part of the property shown on plat of Property of W.A. Holliday, recorded in Plat Book F, at page #167, and being shown more particularly described, according to survey made by R.E. Dalton, November 1925, as follows.....

Beginning at an iron pin on the Northern side of Bramlett Road, at corner of property, owned by Southern Power Company, said point being 90 feet distant from the East Side of Holliday Avenue, and running thence with line of Southern Power Company property, N. 6-02 W. 175.6 feet to pin, thence continuing with the line of said property, and other property formerly owned by A.W. Holiday, N. 49-35 E. 89-8 feet to pin, thence S. 12-35 E. 226.5 feet to an iron pin on Bramlett Road thence along the North Side of Bramlett Road, S. 83-31 W. 100 feet to the point of beginning.....
