MORTGAGE OF ANTHONY E. WALLACE, ET AL IN FAVOR OF THE FEDERAL LAND BANK OF COLUMBIA, COLUMBIA, SOUTH CAROLINA, DATED 25TH DAY OF JULY, 1973.
