## MORTGAGE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

WILLIAM R. MEADORS AND JOYCE L. MEADORS  
(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto CAROLINA FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, Greenville, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of Eight Thousand Seven Hundred and No/100-----

DOLLARS (\$8,700.00), with interest thereon as provided in said promissory note, said principal and interest to be paid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose, and

WHEREAS, the unpaid balance of said debt or debts, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable,

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being at the Northeastern corner of the intersection of Fairview Street and Woodside Avenue (formerly Church Street) in the Town of Fountain Inn, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 75 as shown on plat entitled "Woodside Mills, Fountain Inn, South Carolina", dated October, 1952, prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book BB, Page 83, and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northeastern side of Woodside Avenue (formerly Church Street) at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 74 and 75 and running thence with the Northeastern side of Woodside Avenue (formerly Church Street) N. 36-48 W. 100.0 feet to an iron pin at the Northeastern corner of the intersection of Fairview Street and Woodside Avenue (formerly Church Street); thence with the Northeastern side of Fairview Street, N. 53-32 E. 38.0 feet to an iron pin on the Southern side of the right of way of C & W C Railroad; thence with the Southern side of the right of way of C & W C Railroad, N. 79-12 E. 149.2 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 22-44 E. 41.4 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 74 and 75; thence with the line of Lot No. 74 S. 55-53 W. 161.5 feet to the point of beginning.
