WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may bereafter become indebted to the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN. That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagor to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (43.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagor at and before the scaling of these presents, the receipt whereof is bereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagor, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or bereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, bing and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the southern side of Old Georgia Road, being known and designated as Lot No. 5 as shown on plat entitled PROPERTY OF W. C. KILPATRICK, dated September, 1949, prepared by W. J. Riddle, R.L.S., and recorded in the R. H. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "T", at Page 209, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of Old Georgia Road at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 4 and 5 and running thence with the common line of said Lots, S. 28-22 E. 189.8 feet to an iron pin; thence running N. 76-58 E. 78.5 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 5 and 6; thence running with the common line of said Lots, N. 22-30 W. 177 feet to an iron pin on the southern side of Old Georgia Road; thence running with the southern side of said Road, S. 77-10 W. 100 feet to the point of beginning.
