TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and opportunities to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, including all built-in stoves and refrigerators, heating, air conditioning, plunding and electrical fixtures, wall to wall carpeting, fences, and gates, and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached connected or fitted in any manner, it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than household furniture, he considered a part of the realty.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns forever.

The Mortgagor represents and warrants that said Mortgagor is seized of the above described premises in fee simple absolute; that the above described premises are free and clear of all hers or other encumbrances, that the Mortgagor is lawfully empowered to convey or encumber the same; and that the Mortgagor will forever detend the said premises unto the Mortgagor, its successors and assigns, from and against the Mortgagor and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

THE MORTGAGOR COVENANTS AND AGREES AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the Mortgagor will promptly pay the principal and interest on the indebtedness evidenced by said promissory note at the times and in the manner therein provided.
- 2. That this mortgage will secure the Mortgagee for any additional sums which may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the payment of taxes, or public assessments, hazard insurance premiums, repairs or other such purposes pursuant to the provisions of this mortgage, and also for any loans or advances that may hereafter be made by the Mortgagee to the Mortgagor under the authority of Sec. 45-55, 1962 Code of laws of South Carolina, as amended, or similar statutes; and all sums so advanced shall bear interest at the same rate or rates as that provided in said note unless otherwise agreed upon by the parties and shall be payable at the demand of the Mortgagee, unless otherwise provided in writing.
- 3. That Mortgagor will keep the improvements on the mortgaged premises, whether now existing or hereafter to be crected, insured against loss by fire, windstorm and other hazards in a sum not less than the balance due hereunder at any time and in a company or companies acceptable to the Mortgager, and Mortgagor does hereby assign the policy or policies of insurance to the Mortgager and agrees that all such policies shall be held by the Mortgager should it so require and shall include loss payable clauses in favor of the Mortgager; and in the event of loss, Mortgagor will give immediate notice thereof to the Mortgager by registered much and should the Mortgagor at any time fail to keep said premises insured or fail to pay the premiums for such insurance, then the Mortgager may cause such improvements to be insured in the name of the Mortgagor and reimburse itself for the cost of such insurance, with interest as hereinabove provided.
- 4. That the Mortgagor will keep all improvements upon the mortgaged premises in good repair, and should Mortgagor fail to do so, the Mortgagoe may, at its option, enter upon said premises and make whatever repairs are necessary and charge the expenses for such repairs to the mortgage debt and collect the same under this mortgage, with interest as hereinabove provided.
- 5. That the Mortgagee may at any time require the issuance and maintenance of insurance upon the life of any person obligated under the indebtedness secured hereby in a sum sufficient to pay the mortgage debt, with the Mortgagee as beneficiary, and if the premiums are not otherwise paid, the Mortgagee may pay said premiums and any amount so paid shall become a part of the mortgage debt.
- 6. That Mortgagor agrees to pay all taxes and other public assessments levied against the mortgaged premises on or before the due dates thereof and to exhibit the receipts therefor at the offices of the Mortgagee immediately upon payment, and should the Mortgagor fail to pay such taxes and assessments when the same shall fall due, the Mortgagee may, at its option pay the same and charge the amounts so paid to the mortgage debt and collect the same under this mortgage, with interest as also e provided.
- 7. That if this mortgage secures a "construction loan", the Mortgagor agrees that the principal amount of the indebtedness hereby secured shall be dishursed to the Mortgagor in periodic payments, as construction progresses, in accordance with the terms and conditions of a Construction Loan Agreement which is separately executed but is made a part of this mortgage and incorporated herein by reference.
- S. That the Martz gar will not further enginaler the premises always described, without the prior consent of the Mortzagoe, and should the Martzagor so enougher such premises, the Mortgagoe may, at its option declare the indebtedness hereby secured to be immediately due and payable and may institute any proceedings necessary to collect said indebtedness.
- 9. That should the Mortzazor abenate the mortzazol premises by Contract of Sale, Borel for Title, or Deed of Conveyance, and the within mortgaze includedness is not paid in full, the Mortzazor or his Funchaser shall be required to file with the Association an application for an assumption of the mortzazo includedness, pay the reasonable cost as required by the Association for processing the assumption furnish the Association with a copy of the Contract of Sale, Borel for Title, or Deed of Conveyance, and have the interest rate on the lain bulinese existing at the time of transfer modified by increasing the interest rate on the sull bun bulince to the maximum rate per annum permitted to be charged at that time by applicable South Carolina law, or a lesser increase in interest rate as may be determined by the Association. The Association will notify the Mortzazor or his processor of the new interest rate and monthly payments and will mull him a new passbook. Should the Mortzazor, or his Funchasor, full to comply with the provisions of the within paragraph the Mortzazor, at its option may declare the indebtedness hardly secured to be immediately due and payable and may institute any proceedings necessary to collect said indebtedness.
- 10. That should the Mortzagor fad to make payments of principal and interest as does on the promissory note and the same shall be unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days or if there should be any fedure to comply with and abide by any by-laws or the charter of the Mortgagoe, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the Mortgagoe at its option now write to the Mortgagor at his last known address giving him thirty (30) days in which to rectify the said default and should the Mortgagor ful to rectify said default within the said thirty days the Mortgagoe, may, at its option, increase the interest rate on the loan before for the recasining term of the loan or for a lesser term to the maximum rate per anomic permitted to be charged at that time by applicable South Carolina law, or a lesser increase rate as may be determined by the Association. The monthly payments will be a histed accordingly.
- 11. That should the Mortgagor field to make payments of principal real interest is died on the premissivy note and should any monthly installment become past due for a period in excess of 15 days, the Mortgagor may collect a "lite charge" not to exceed an amount equal to five (5%) per centum of any such past due installment in order to cover the extra expense incident to the hundling of such delinquent payments.
- 12.
