MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and essigns;

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Bates Township, on White Horse Road, and having the following metes and bounds according to a survey made by W. A. Hester, Dated July 6th, 1946, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the north west side of the White Horse Road at light pole and running thence N. 34 W 22.53 Chs to iron pin; thence S. 38 W. 8.51 to a stone O. M.; thence S. 34 E. 21.00 to an iron pin on the White Horse Road; thence along said Road N. 48 1/2 E. 8.13 to the beginning corner, and containing 17 1/2 acres, more or less. Bounded by lands of Brown and others.

THIS being that same property conveyed to Mortgagee by Deed of Gladys Terrell on August 2nd, 1946, and being recorded in the RMC Office for County & State aforesaid in Book 298, Page 361.

ALSO, this being that same property conveyed to the said Gladys Terrell on July 2nd, 1940 by Emma Williams, and being recorded in the RMC Office for County & State aforesaid, in Book 266, Page 233.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its heirs, successors and assigns, forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that it is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that it has good right and is lawfully authorized to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances except as provided herein. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagoe forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomspever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
