TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: VIRGINIA A. MERCK

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the sum of Fifty Thousand and No/100-----DOLLARS

(\$ 50,000.00), as evidenced by the Mortgagor's note of even date, bearing interest as stated in said note, and payable as therein stated or as modified by mutual agreement, in writing, the final maturity of which is **twenty-five** years after the date hereof, unless extended by mutual consent, the terms of said note and any agreement modifying it are incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced or readvanced to or for the Mortgagor's account, including advances made by the Mortgagee on other or no security:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

All those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying and being on the northwestern side of Jervey Road and being known and designated as Lots 8, 9, 10 and 11 of Hillandale Estates as shown on a plat thereof recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book "B", Page 145, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northwest side of Jervey Road, joint front corner of Lots 7 and 8, and running thence with the joint line of Lots 7 and 8, N. 38-30 W. 387 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 7 and 8; thence along the rear line of Lots 8, 9, 10 and 11, N. 51-30 E. 400 feet to an iron pin at the corner of property now or formerly belonging to W. H. Austin; thence with Austin's line, S. 31-30 E. 351.8 feet to an iron pin on the northwest side of Jervey Road; thence along the northwestern side of Jervey Road, S. 38-15 W. 162.5 feet to an iron pin, joint front corner of Lots 9 and 10; thence still with Jervey Road, S. 51-02 W. 200 feet to the beginning corner.

ALSO: All that piece, parcel or lot of land joining the premises hereinabove described on the easterly side thereof and having, according to a survey made by J. Mac Richardson, Surveyor, September, 1953, the following metes and bounds:

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.

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
