We, Buryl B. Smith and Mary C. Smith

SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, we the said Buryl B. Smith and Mary C. Smith

in and by our certain promisory note in writing of even date with these Presents, are well and truly indebted unto the CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, Greer, S. C., in the full and just sum of Ten Thousand and no/100 - - - - - (\$ 10,000.00) Dollars, with interest from the date hereof at the rate of eight 1/2 per cent (8 1/2 %) per annum, unpaid interest to bear interest at the same rate, to be repaid in installments of

Smith, in consideration of the said debt and sums of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, Greer, S. C., according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to us the said mortgagee, in hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagee, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents (receipt of which is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, Greer, S.
