NOW. KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt/and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the scaling and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

ALL that certain tract of land situate on the west side of the Seaboard Coast Line Railroad and on both sides of Lakeside Drive in Gantt Township, S. C., comprising the easterly portion of Tract No. 1 on a Plat dated November 27, 1967, by John A. Simmons, surveyor of record in the office of the R.M.C. of Greenville County in Plat Book PPP at Page 195 containing 51.37 acres, more or less, and having the following courses and distances:

Beginning at a point at the southeasterly corner of the property herein described on the westerly edge of the Seaboard Coast Line Railroad right-of-way; thence N. 19-22 W., 596.27 feet to an iron pin corner; thence N. 72-18 W., 100 feet; thence N. 67-58 W., 579.78 feet to a corner; thence N. 20-55 E., 2135 feet to a corner; thence S.59-47 E., 1079.13 feet to a corner on the westerly edge of said railroad right-of-way; thence S. 20-55 W., 2421.1 feet to the beginning corner.
