Parcel 13

A certain parcel or tract lying and being in the Town of Campobello, State and County aforesaid, and on West side of Street, or Public Road, sometimes referred to as "Molow Road" leading from Campobello toward Greenville Courthouse, said lot of land hereby conveyed BOUNDED by said Street or Public Road on East, by lands now or formerly of C. Parcel 14
