TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: Joseph B. Dill and Judith Y. Dill

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto WOODRUFF FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of TWENTY THOUSAND and no/100---

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the North side of South Carolina Highway no. 101 in Highland Township, containing Two and 06/100 (2.06) acres, more or less, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit: Beginning at a Nail & Cap in said highway and running thence N.1-45 W.740 feet to an old Iron Pin, thence N. 58-00 E.76.2 feet to an Iron Pin, thence S.27-06 E.324 feet to an Iron Pin, thence S.23-04 W.244 feet to an Iron Pin, thence S.14-15 W.290 feet to a Nail & Cap in said highway, thence with said highway N.64-15 W.25 feet to the beginning point.
