NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on MountainCreek Road, being known and designated as Lot No. 2 on Plat of Property of H.G. Stevens, made by W.J. Riddle, Surveyor, April 1941, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book M at page 9. According to said plat, the property is more fully described as follows:

The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagoe forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
