The right is reserved to anticipate the payment of said indebtedness, in whole or in part, without the payment of interest beyond the date of any such anticipated payment.

granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

MAUDE P. KING:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Greenville Township, on the south side of Hillcrest Drive, being known and designated as Lot No. 11, of Block A, as shown on plat thereof made by R. E. Dalton in October, 1936, from surveys made by W. J. Riddle and R. E. Dalton, recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book K, at page 121, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: BEGINNING at an iron pin on the south side of Hillcrest Drive at the corner of Lot No. 10, of Block A, and running thence along the line of said lot, S. 9-52 W. 190 feet to an iron pin on the north side of an alley; thence along the line of said alley, N. 80-08 W. 70 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 12, of Block A; thence along the line of that lot, N. 9-52 E. 190 feet to an iron pin on the south side of Hillcrest Drive; thence along the line of said Hillcrest Drive, S. 80-08 E. 70 feet to the beginning corner.

The above described lot is composed of all of Lot No. 11 and 20 feet of Lot No. 12, of Block A, of an old plat of Highland Terrace recorded in the R. M.C. office of Greenville County in Plat Book E, at page 101.
